Non-sworn, civilian employees, technicians, or other professionals who are employed in a direct operational support role; or members of the National Guard & Reserves may also attend restricted enrollment programs, providing such training is required in order to perform their government, or U.S. military, DOD, or intelligence related duties.

**SPECIAL NOTICE:** The TSS series of Lock Courses are specifically designed for those individuals who will be charged with performing sanctioned secret entries for the purpose of executing the authorizing provisions of federal laws which deal with court-ordered wire, or oral communications intercepts of conversations; the seizure of other electronic data ordered by a federal court of competent jurisdiction; or to provide emergency, silent entry support for classified military activities/operations as ordered.

**SURREPTITIOUS ENTRY OPERATIONS, LEVEL II** - This advanced entry course is an intense 40 plus hour program of formal classroom instruction and a series of closely supervised, structured practical exercises (PRACTEX) which will provide the operator who has successfully completed the Basic TSS Surreptitious Entry Operations I course, or possesses equivalent lock training. After a brief review of basic clandestine entry principles, techniques and an instructor evaluation of each students discipline-specific manual skills, the student's will be exposed to new lock/access technology and hardware, including electronic access control systems; vehicle entry and master keying. Specific instruction is also provided on new key impressing techniques; advanced lock picking and by-passes, and the manipulated opening of mechanical access systems. Time is also devoted to teaching the students how to make field expedient vehicle opening tools and special purpose lock picks from readily available items. And since new lock by-pass techniques are constantly being developed, each student will receive an update on these methods.

The TSS series of Surreptitious Entry courses represent the very best special entry POI's available to law enforcement officers and special military operators. This course will teach students how to use a variety of different, and innovative key impressing techniques which can often be used to make a

properly cut key for locks that are either difficult to pick, or are rake resistant. Each student will be taught how to visually decode locks and then make properly cut keys to open these locks. They will also learn how to make keys utilizing key duplication and cutting-to-code machines, including the fabrication of a basic set of "bump" keys.
