The first program of instruction (POI), **Technical Surveillance Operations I** will be conducted from **Monday, November 07 thru Friday, November 11, 2011.**

TECHNICAL SURVEILLANCE OPERATIONS I is a 40 plus hour POI especially designed for those officers or agents who require formal training in the hands-on use of audio and RF investigative equipment and related concealment and operational techniques. The emphasis of this course is on concealed body-worn or body-carried RF transmitters and small investigative tape recorders that are used during undercover, or special police investigations, and how to consistently produce clear, intelligible evidence quality tape recordings for the Prosecutor or District Attorney. Additionally, each student will be taught how to build an electret body transmitter microphone; RF antenna and a miniature audio amplifier, which will be theirs to keep, and use after the course. The lifetime electronic craftsmanship skills acquired during this course will also allow the student to make minor repairs to, and maintain a wide variety of electronic surveillance equipment and devices.

Our second course, **Video Surveillance Operations I** will be conducted from **Monday, November 14 thru Friday, November 18, 2011.**

VIDEO SURVEILLANCE OPERATIONS I is a 40 plus hour POI which stresses basic information and hands-on-the-equipment investigative techniques that are necessary in order to properly use video surveillance equipment in support of undercover investigations and other covert police operations. Students will be taught how to install and conceal cameras in rooms and other "fixed locations"; how to operate from motor vehicles; how to place the “real-time” audio from a body transmitter onto the "sound" track of a video tape; how to use video against "street" criminals; conceal & do portable hand-carries of covert video systems, and a host of other subjects and techniques. The students will fabricate a variety of audio and video interconnect cables; a microphone power supply and a Infrared flasher/beacon all which are theirs to keep and use after the course.

SKILL OBJECTIVES: TSS prides itself in presenting the very highest quality Technical Surveillance training available in a cost-effective manner.
